

Contact Tracing for COVID-19

Berea College is following the contact-tracing guidelines created by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and coordinated by the Madison County Health Department. This document is designed to share the contact-tracing plan with the Berea College campus community.

Important contract-tracing definitions

1. **Patient:** A person who is laboratory-confirmed or is probable COVID-19 positive (based on symptoms).
2. **Close Contact:** A person who is identified to be within six feet of an infected person (either laboratory-confirmed or probable COVID-19 patient) for at least 15 minutes or more.
3. **Non-Close Contact:** A person who had limited or intermittent contact with a patient but did not meet the criteria as a close contact (e.g., a faculty member has a student in class that tested positive, but all maintained physical distance and used appropriate PPE).

Depending on the contact level you have with the patient, you may or may not be contacted by the Madison County Health Department Case Manager and/or Berea College Human Resources (for faculty and staff) or Berea College Student Life (for students).
