

Berea College COVID-19 Testing Program for Employees

Dear Bereans,

As previously communicated to campus, the College will conduct a continuing COVID-19 testing program through Catholic Health Initiatives (CHI) for employees working on campus during the Fall 2020 Term. Students living and working on campus will take part in a testing program arranged by Student Life with White House Clinics. These testing programs are intended to help our community prevent spread of the virus. More information on the student testing program will be provided by Student Life.

For Employees:


Arrangements have been made with CHI to test 10 different employees each day between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. at a drive-up testing location situated at St. Joseph's Hospital adjacent to campus. This schedule will ensure that each on-campus employee is tested during the Fall 2020 Term. The October and November schedules will be released soon. **Your testing is mandatory. An unexcused absence from your mandatory test may lead to a required leave of absence from work without pay for 14 days.**

Also attached is a map of the employee testing location. Travel to and from the testing site should be considered as time worked and should only take about 10 minutes. There will be no charge for testing; you simply need to provide your name and a picture ID such as your Berea College ID or a driver's license for verification.

In the interest of obtaining employee test results as quickly as possible to minimize risk on campus, the College has arranged for CHI to send results directly to Steve Lawson in Human Resources. Results are expected within 48 to 72 hours of testing, after which employees will receive a confidential email from Steve Lawson informing them of their results. Employees wishing to receive a copy of their results directly from CHI may obtain it at the Records Office at St. Joseph's Hospital in Berea. Human Resources and the Risk Management team will keep test results confidential, except as required by the Public Health Department to facilitate contact tracing or provide support services to any employees affected by positive results.

Lastly, any employee who is concerned that they may have contracted COVID should self-report their situation to Steve Lawson in Human Resources at lawsonst@berea.edu. In such instances, additional testing can be arranged through Human Resources.
