

LABOR PROGRAM COVID-19 POLICY SUMMER 2021

As per normal Labor Program policy, all degree-seeking students living on campus in the Summer 2021 Term will be expected work at least 10 hours per week. Summer practicum students who reside on campus are permitted to work up to 40 hours. In order to help safeguard the health of the Berea College campus community, **non-residential students will not be permitted to work on campus in the summer of 2021**. Full-time students who are not residential, but who are taking online courses, may be able to telework depending on their labor position.

Exceptions to participation in the Labor Program will be determined on a case-by-case basis by the Dean of Labor. This policy may be revisited if the status of the public health emergency changes.
